Because of primary source repositories like the AIHA, 5450 historical artifacts, 85,000 photographs, 300 architectural renderings and maps, 1000 linear feet of manuscripts, and 500 linear feet of museum archives that are all related to Albany and New York can be stored and preserved for monumental historic exhibits like the Hudson River Panorama.
