- TBL's original vision
 - “Weaving the Web” – 1999
- Then: Focus on Machine Reasoning
 - Scientific American Article
- Now: Focus on things & links
 - Reasoning & Inferencing less central



- Originally:
 - Metadata standard built on XML
 - Metadata about “Web” things (documents)
- Eventually:
 - Metadata about *all* sorts of things
 - And about *relationships between* things



- Use URIs as names for things
- Use HTTP URIs so that people can look up those names.
- When someone looks up a URI, provide useful information.
- Include links to other URIs. so that they can discover more things.

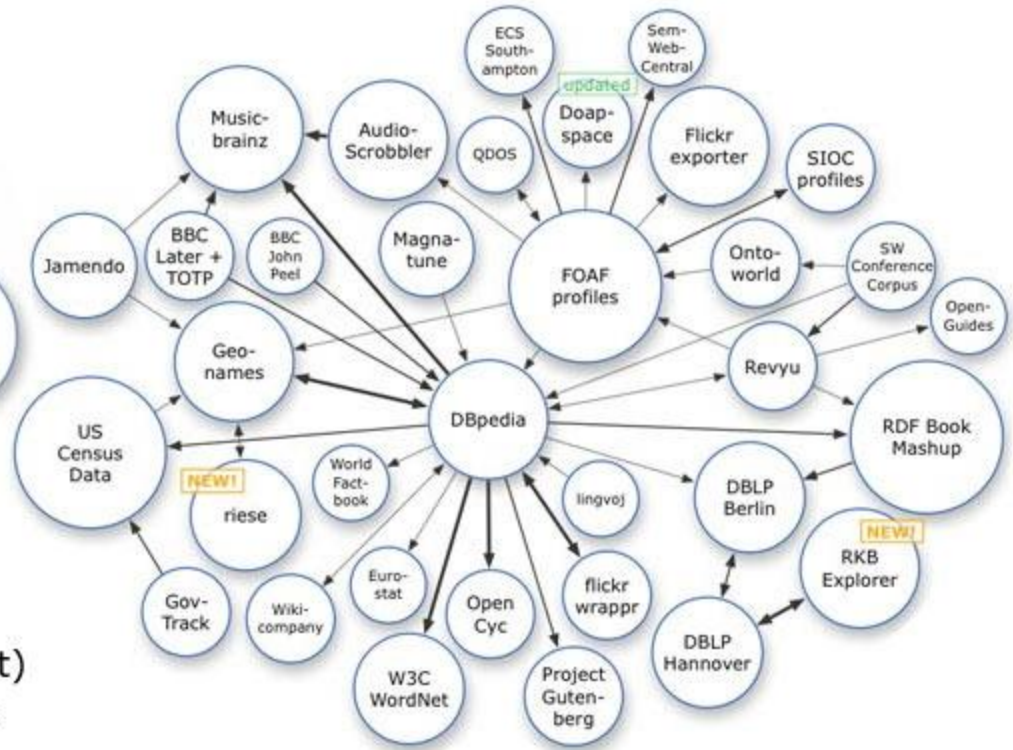
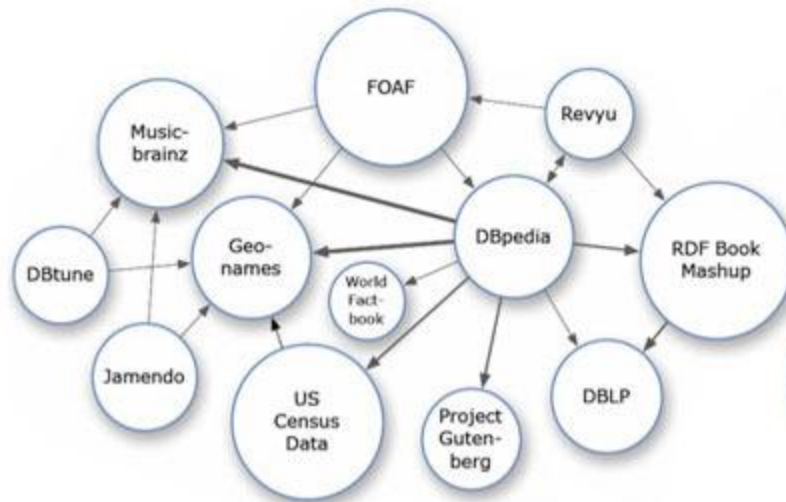

- Metadata as a Graph
- Typed “things”, named by URIs
- The relationships between those things, also built on URIs
- Ease of integration *across* data sources – “merging graphs”

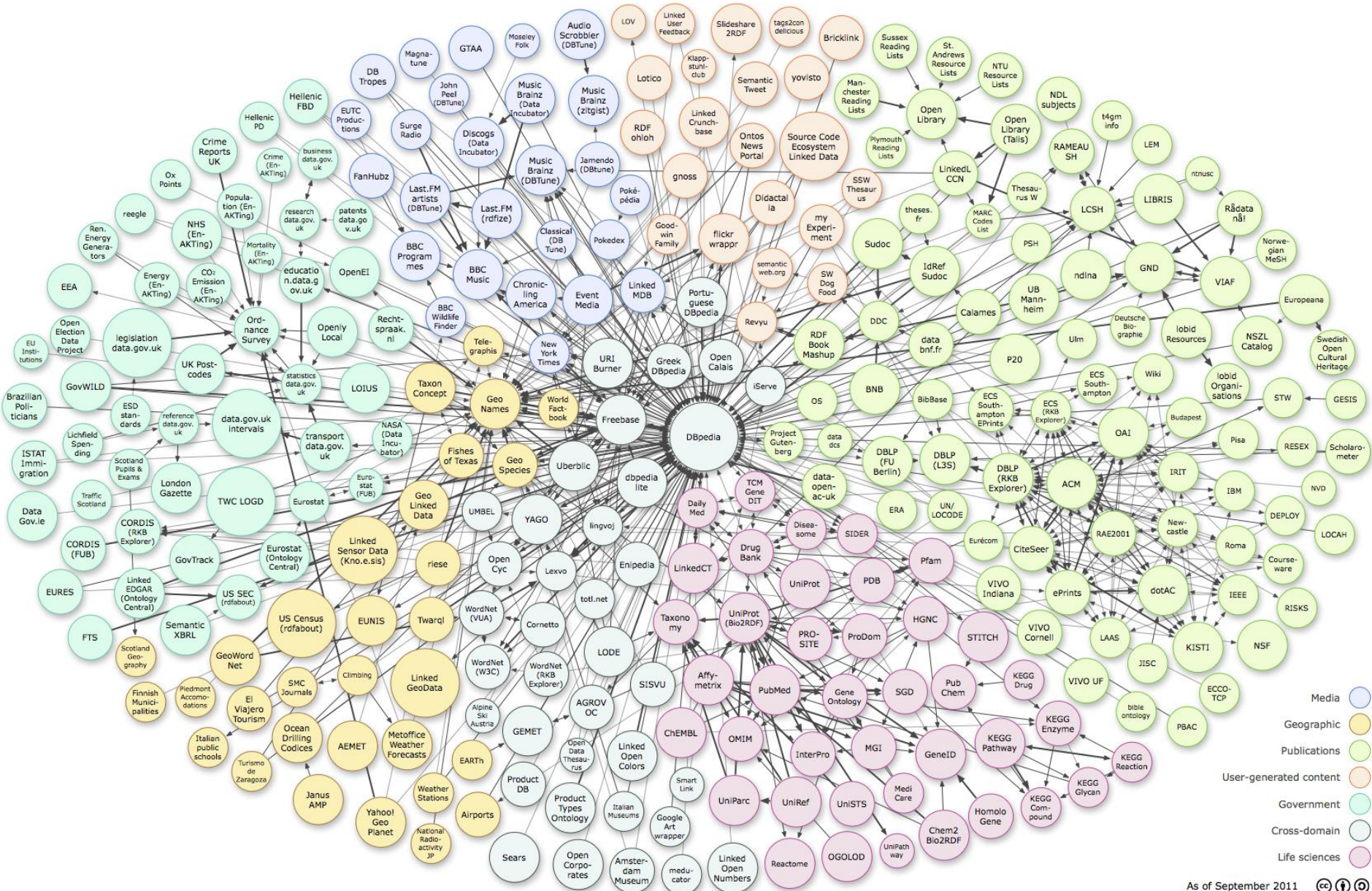


Growth of the Linked Data cloud

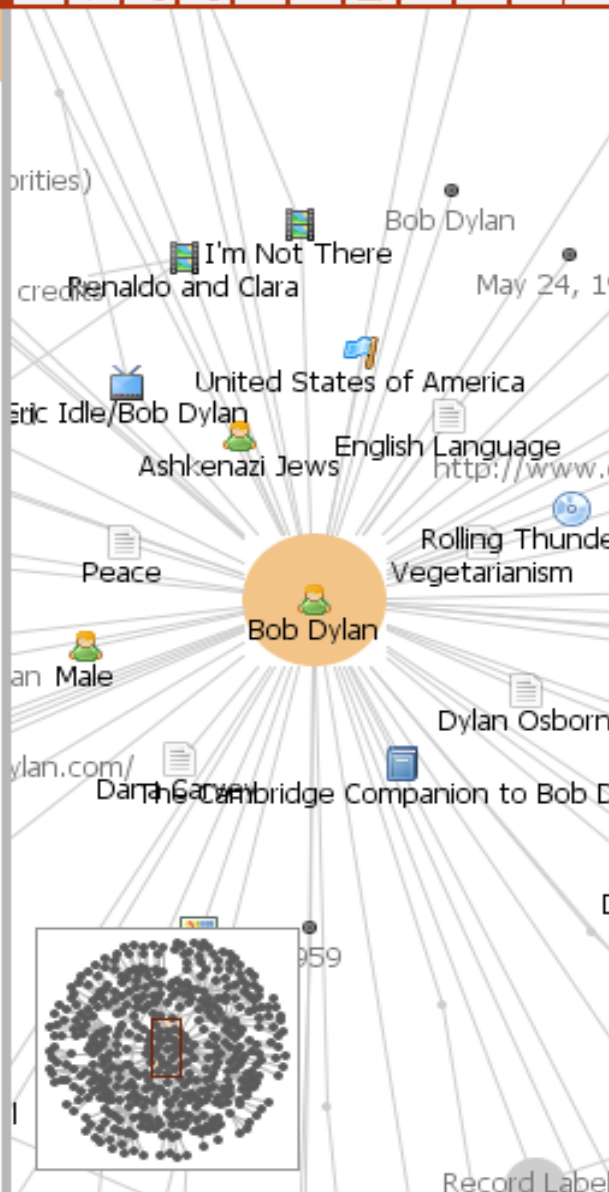

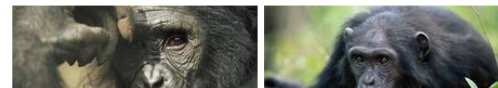

Chimps form 'super group' of 22 at Edinburgh Zoo

A "super group" of 22 chimps has finally joined together at Edinburgh Zoo.

Eleven new chimps have integrated with the existing 11 resident chimps in the Budongo Trail.

The trail is the world's largest chimpanzee enclosure, according to officials at Edinburgh Zoo.

It has taken almost six months to complete the integration of the two groups as chimps live in complex communities.

Due to hierarchical groupings, keepers closely observed the status level of every chimp in the new group and correlated this to the nearest in status in the existing one.

Jo Richardson, head keeper at Budongo Trail, said: "It is important for the success of the integration to know individuals well as chimps have a lot of group politics and social dynamics, and are an extremely intelligent and volatile species.

"This has been the biggest challenge and achievement for all the team at Budongo Trail so far, as this is the largest integration of chimps we have ever undertaken.

Ms Richardson said the resident chimps have individual characteristics and when a new group is brought in it must be handled in the right way to ensure that no chimps' status is challenged initially as the two groups come together.

"So you start with those with the lowest status then gradually progress up the status ladder until you get to the highest level and those being the alpha males," she said.

"This is done at the chimps' pace to ensure all group members have a chance to settle and integrate well with hopefully minimal aggression, as chimps will sort out hierarchy and dynamics through both affiliative behaviour and sometimes fighting."

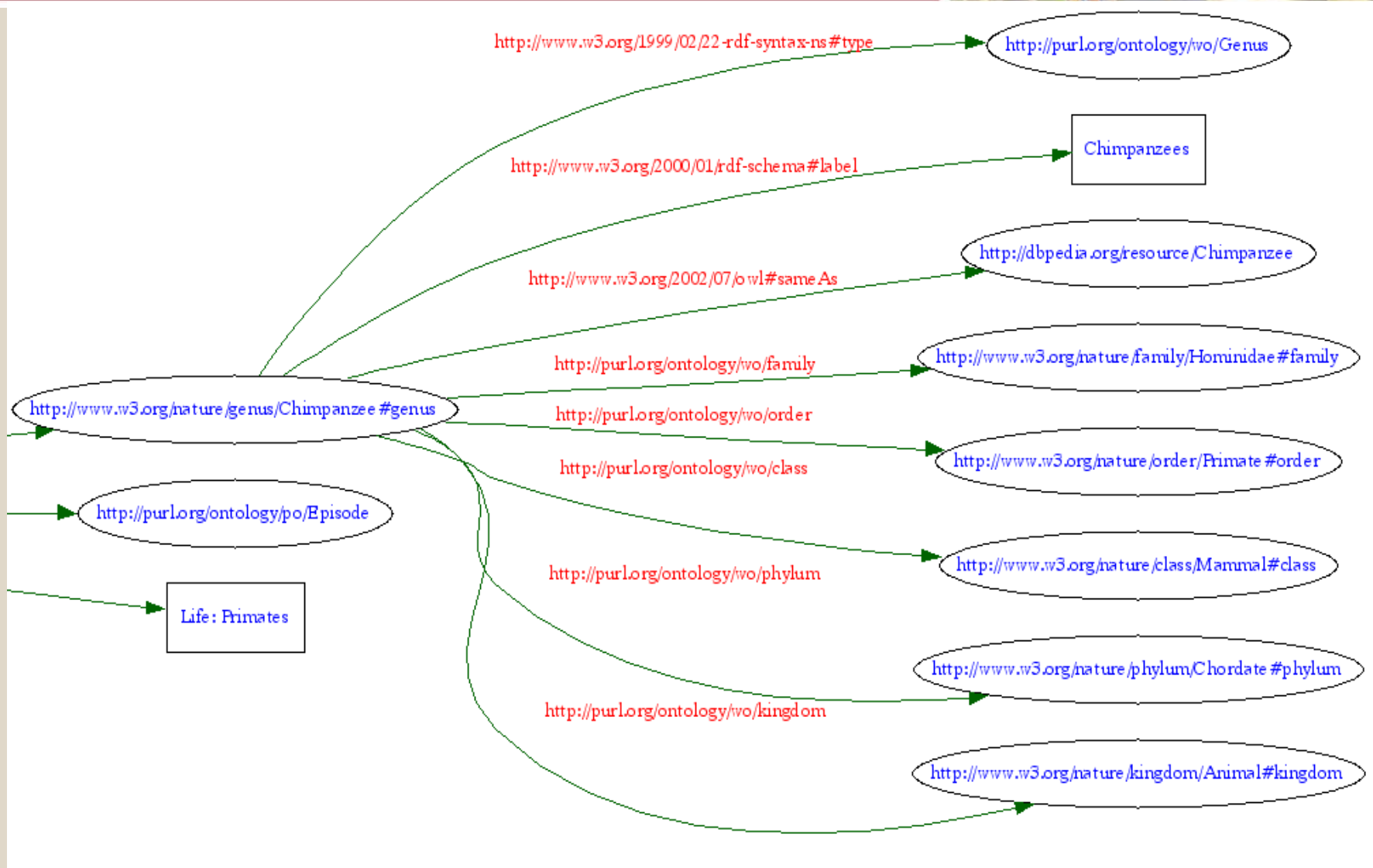
Chimp hierarchies do not have a strict "pecking order", but are complex, fluid, flexible, and change often.

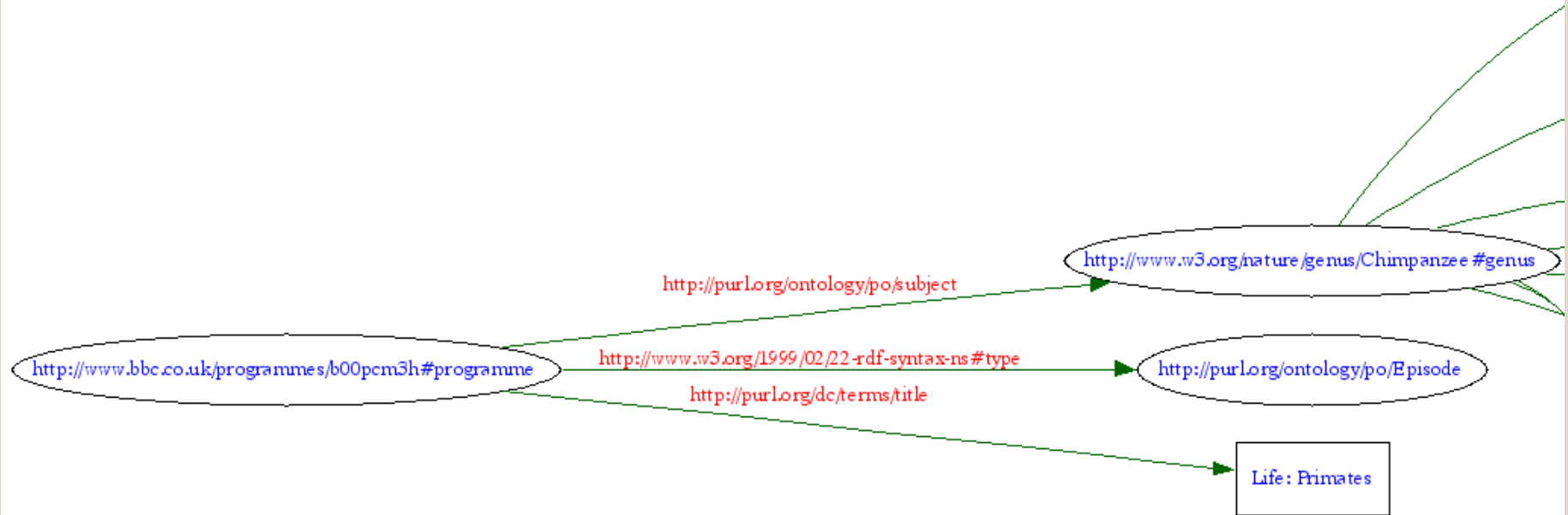


The Budongo Trail can hold up to 40 chimpanzees but has 22 now

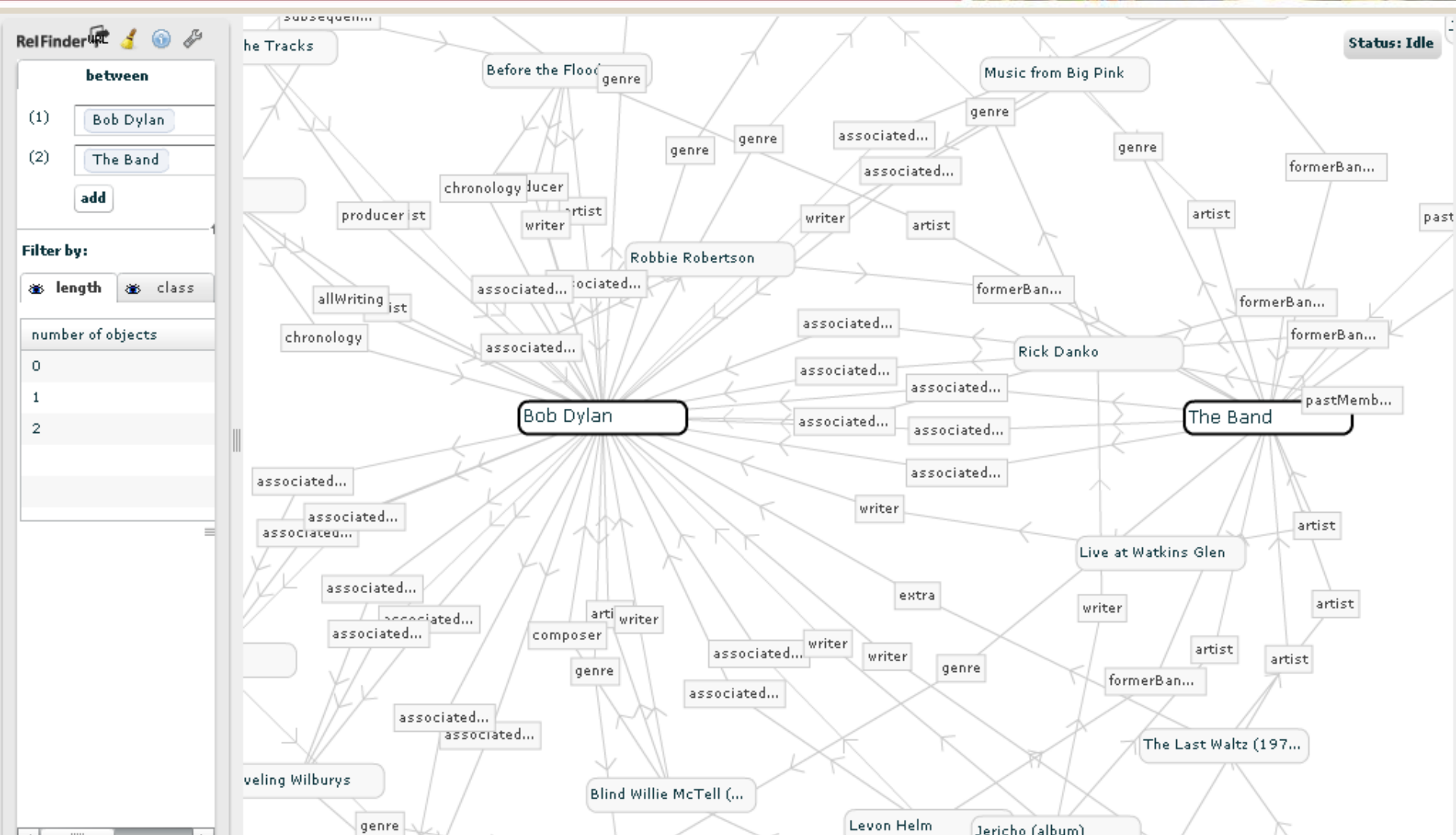

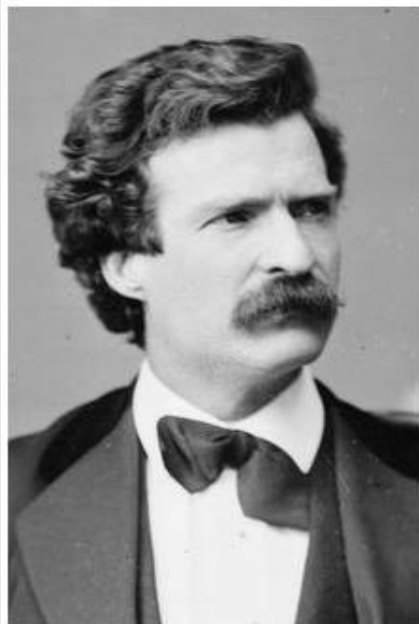

OVERVIEW



Samuel Langhorne Clemens (November 30, 1835 – April 21, 1910), well known by his pen name Mark Twain, was an American author and humorist. Twain is noted for his novels *Adventures of Huckleberry Finn* (1885), which has been called "the Great American Novel", and *The Adventures of Tom Sawyer* (1876). Twain was a friend to presidents, artists, industrialists, and European royalty. Twain was very popular, and his keen wit and incisive satire earned praise from critics and peers. Upon his death he was lauded as the "greatest American humorist of his age", and William Faulkner called Twain "the father of American literature".

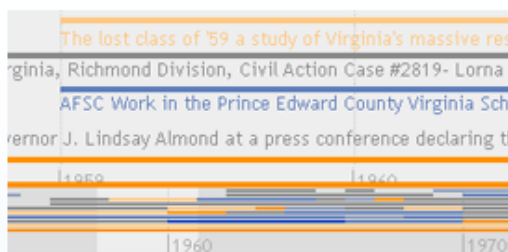
