This is a preliminary cataloging of the SAA Newsletter from July-August, 1974 through May, 1977. It is not a complete listing of the contents of the newsletter. We have tried to include the topics discussed in the major articles. Sections such as "People and Papers," "Meetings," and "Placement" have not been broken down further than merely listing where they appeared in each issue. Generally few persons are listed as entries. When they have been included the criterion used was their impact on the profession as a whole and because they represented a significant issue facing the profession at that time.
