## What Are We Doing With That Gain?

- Past several years, building Technology Fund to upgrade SAA's technical infrastructure to best of breed
  - Nimble AMS and LMS integration
  - Higher Logic (SAA Connect)
- ► Live-streaming pilot of Annual Meeting content for the first time here in Austin
- Maintaining cash reserves for fiscal solvency and future Council initiatives

## New Association Management System

- ▶ Nimble AMS fully launched in April
- New online bookstore, membership renewal portal, education registration and administration, and SAA Connect (group lists)
- Enhanced collaboration tools for sections and committees
- ► Improved security of member data

## SAA Program Areas: Membership

- Membership numbers plateaued: 5,822 members, down 3.93%
- ► Revenue from dues increased by 3.46% in FY '19
- Dues and Annual Meeting revenue are the life blood of SAA's budget


# SAA Program Areas: Publications & Periodicals
